

Wytheville Farmers Market
Post-Season Membership Meeting
November 19, 2019

The Wytheville Farmers Market post-season membership meeting was held Tuesday, November 19, 2019 at the Farmers Market Building. The meeting was called to order at 7:05 PM by Emily Davis, Vice Chairman

Shawn Boucher, Secretary was unable to attend the meeting.

Judy Buck, Treasurer presented the financial report for the year ending October 31, 2019. November 1, 2018 balance of \$17,824.30 plus receipts for the year totaling \$39,452.54 less expenses of \$31,346.12 leaving a fund balance of \$25, 930.72 as of October 31, 2019. The Treasurer's report was unanimously approved.

Greg Smith, Market Manager presented the year end summer market report. Greg shared statistics representing sales comparisons between years 2016, 2017, 2018 and 2019 with a growth in sales of 5.4% increase for 2019 over the previous years. 2019 sales by category for the summer market showed meats leading at 24%, produce at 23%, baked goods 18% for the top three categories. Summer market vendor participation ranged from 20% to 30% over the four-year period. 2019/20 fiscal year budget funding included 77% from Grant Funds, 15% from Vendor Fees, 5% from Sponsors and 3% from Fundraiser. Total year budget \$29,900.

Board member election was held. Elected to serve three-year terms were Amy Roberts, DeeDee Thigpen and Alvin Cassell.

With no further questions or comments the meeting was adjourned at 7:30 PM.
