

Wytheville Farmers Market
Meeting Minutes
June 9, 2022 6:30 pm

Wytheville Farmers Market Board Meeting was called to order by Jan Hermansen at 6:30 pm. Jan extended a welcome to all board members.

A motion was made by Julia Stephens to accept the meeting agenda and seconded by Kevin Wallington. Motion passed.

Jan presented a quote to update the market hours on the outside signs, Kevin will check into finding a less expensive way to make these changes.

Judy will check on prices for T-shirts and bags with new designs. Jan talked about the possibility of expanding into other counties and states to receive more WFM funding and looking at the current WFM booth layout.

Julia brought board members up to date on activities for Dairy Day. She will register the market for the parade and did not think there would be a registration charge. They will set up under the shelter with giveaways and the fee ice cream.
